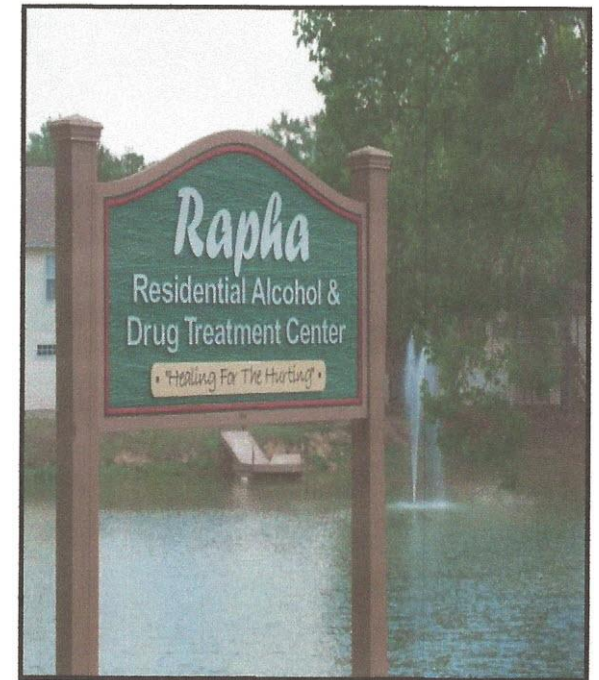

- Females

- IV Drug users
- Individuals HIV positive

Admission requires an ASAM 6 Dimension Assessment. Contact a mental health provider in your community or contact our administrative office to schedule an assessment appointment.
